Each indicator is then analysed, subject to the availability of statistics, by socio-economic group, and protected characteristic (gender, age, ethnicity, disability, religious belief and sexual orientation).

The findings are presented using a mix of text, tables and graphs. The sources of all data will be clearly provided should you wish to explore them further.
